#### <u>431/22-23 – DEVELOPMENT PERMITS #001, 002, 003, & 004-2023</u> <u>MOVED BY DELAINEY</u>

That the Council acknowledge that permitted-use development applications were received to construct an approach, construction of a wellsite and access road for drilling a well for Petroleum and/or Natural Gas on:

NW 7-38-19 W3M - Application #001-2023,

SE 6-38-19 W3M - Application #002-2023,

NE 31-37-19 W3M - Application #003-2023,

N ½ 6-38-19 W3M - Application #004-2023; and

That Development Permits #001-, 002, 003, and 004-2023 were issued subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The municipality's well drilling license fee is \$250.00 plus \$100.00 administration fee.
- 2. There will be an operational fee of \$6,000 charged on every oil and gas well drilling license issued.
- 3. No above-ground facilities, rock, dirt piles, etc. may be within 61 meters from centerline of road allowance or within 91 meters from the intersection of two or more roads.
- 4. No drilling within 61 meters from the center of developed road allowances.
- 5. Road approaches are to be constructed in accordance with Policy 1602 of the R.M. of Reford No. 379:
  - applications for approaches must be submitted in writing to the R.M. of Reford;
  - there must be an appropriate site distance;
  - the approach onto all developed roads must have a minimum 20 foot top and 3:1 slope;
  - a 450 mm 500 mm diameter culvert must be installed on new approaches; ands
  - an approach entering onto a gravel road must be graveled at the time of construction.
- 6. The municipality's approach approval fee is \$50.00 per well site location.

- 7. All vehicles must comply with Saskatchewan Highway's secondary weight regulations. Non-divisible loads exceeding secondary weight limits require a municipal overweight permit.
- 8. Speed limit on Municipal roads is 80 km per hour. Speed limit on overweight loads is 60 km per hour.
- Approval of this application is and issue of a Permit does not absolve the applicant of obtaining other permits and approvals as may be required according to other Municipal, Provincial, and Federal Government legislation.
- 10. Landowner approval is required for any activity off the existing road allowance.
- 11. Development permits expire one (1) year from date of issue.
